

Memorandum of Understanding regarding the Acceptance
Conditions for the Pre-Games Training Camp for the Tokyo 2020
Olympics

1. COVID-19 Countermeasures

- Pre-games training camp participants will be required to take a COVID-19 test within 72 hours before departing for Japan and provide proof of a negative test result to Nihonmatsu City. (A copy is acceptable.)
 - Pre-games training camp participants are required to submit their activity plan for the first 14 days of their stay in Japan to Nihonmatsu City, which they formulated before their departure.
 - At the time of the pre-games training camp, participants are required to download, install, and register on the COVID-19 Contact Confirming COCOA and health reporting smartphone applications (apps).
- *If updates are made to the Official Playbook, we will update this content accordingly.

2. Pre-Games Training Camp Facilities

- There is total exemption on the usage fee of facilities.
 - As a general rule, facilities will be reserved during the period of the pre-games training camp. However, there may be times when we coordinate with school classes and clubs who wish to use the facilities.
 - The following training facilities are available for the Kuwait teams to use
- (1) Nihonmatsu General Shooting Range (clay shooting)
- Available facilities

- Trap Shooting Range (2)
*double trap is possible
- Skeet Shooting Range (2)
(Japan Clay Target Shooting Association Approved A Status)

- Country Park TOWA Athletics Stadium (athletics)

400m length track, all-weatherproof (track: urethane rubber chip, field: natural grass)

Sports

- Track
 - Jumping... long jump, high jump, pole vault
 - Throwing sports.... shot put, javelin throw
- *Can be used for track & field athletic events (fully furnished with competition equipment)
(Japan Association of Athletics Federation Class 4 Certification)

- (2) Towa Junior High School Pool (swimming)

- Available facilities

Outdoor 50m pool (8 lanes, depth 1.2m – 1.5m)

- Sports requiring equipment

After consultation by both parties, Nihonmatsu shall carry out preparations for the sports requiring equipment as much as possible.

- Other

Regarding pre-games training camps for sports that are needed but not listed above, Nihonmatsu shall prepare facilities as much as possible within the city. For the sports that Nihonmatsu cannot accommodate, Nihonmatsu shall prepare facilities in the surrounding municipalities as much as

possible.

3. Accommodation fees, meal costs, and related items

- Depending on the kind of athletic events, Nihonmatsu shall bear the accommodation fees within the budget after it is determined through consultation by both parties.
- Nihonmatsu shall prepare meals within the budget after it is determined through consultation by both parties.
- If you have any other requests, the staff at the accommodation and Nihonmatsu will help you as much as possible.

4. Interpretation

- For the duration of your stay, an interpreter will be present for travel between Tokyo and Nihonmatsu City, events, and daily morning meetings. For regular training and accommodation, Nihonmatsu staff or hotel staff shall be provided with a translation device.

5. Transportation

- Nihonmatsu will provide bus transport from Tokyo to Nihonmatsu City for the pre-games training camp and from the pre-games training camp to the Athletes' Village.
- Nihonmatsu shall provide transportation using dedicated taxis during your stay in Nihonmatsu City (for travel between the training venues and accommodation).

6. Medical Institutions


- A doctor who can speak English is available in Nihonmatsu City.
- There are three general hospitals in Nihonmatsu City that can provide first aid for injuries and illnesses.
- There is a general hospital within a 30-minute drive that can provide first aid for injuries and illnesses.

7. Purpose of Pre-Games Training Camp Invitations

- At the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, it is important to promote the safety and security of Fukushima Prefecture after its recovery from the disaster. For this reason, we believe it is necessary to have many foreigners visit and learn about Nihonmatsu City by attracting pre-games training camps to our city. In addition, we believe that our region will be revitalized by human, economic, cultural exchange with other countries.
- The KOC is committed to collaborating to promote Nihonmatsu City and Fukushima Prefecture. KOC may suggest certain initiatives and activities that can greatly boost the popularity of the Fukushima Prefecture to Kuwait as a country, the Arab region and the entire world.
